In order for your Agency to be exempt from filing a Conflict of Interest Code one of the following exemptions must be met:


1. If the agency were to adopt a Conflict of Interest Code, there would be no "designated employees," within the meaning of California Government Code Sections 82019 and 87302(a), subject to its provisions; or
2. The agency is, or within one year will be, inoperative and nonfunctioning; or
3. The agency is a committee, board, or commission that does not possess decision-making authority as defined in 2 CCR 18701(a)(1) (the Agency does not have regulatory, quasi-regulatory, permit, licensing or planning authority or functions), and both of the following apply:  
and
  - A. The Agency will not acquire real property in the future; and
  - B. The annual operating budget, exclusive of salaries for the Agency, is less than \$150,000; or
4. Good cause exists for granting an exemption due to extraordinary circumstances that indicate the burden on the agency of adopting a conflict of interest code is not warranted by the degree of likelihood that a conflict of interest may occur.
